Erling Hjelmeng is professor at the Department of Private Law, University of Oslo, and affiliated with the Centre for European Law. He is also a visiting professor at the Norwegian School of Economics. His main research and teaching has been in the field of competition law and EU law, with particular focus on enforcement both on a national and international level. He has also published books and articles in the field of tort law.

Hjelmeng has worked in the Norwegian Competition Authority and as an in-house lawyer. Since 2009, he is a co-editor of Tidsskrift for rettsvitenskap (Journal of Legal Science). Currently, he is a leader of the research group Markets – Innovation – Competition at the University of Oslo. He is regularly involved in consulting for law firms and companies as well as for public authorities, and is widely used as a lecturer. He was the Chairman of the committee reviewing the Norwegian Competition Act (2011-12), of the committee drafting an Act on good trading practices in the grocery sector (2012-13), and the committee proposing amendments to the organization of the Norwegian market for agricultural products (2014-15).
